#### Definition





Spiritual gifts are divine abilities distributed by the Holy Spirit to each Christian according to the will of God for the well-being of the body of Christ.






Your personality will affect how and where you use your spiritual gifts.

Personality can be plotted on 4 scales:

Introverted	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	Extraverted

#### How we relate to others:

Introverted 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 Extraverted

Enjoy being with other people, but find that being with others emotionally drains them, so they need a certain amount of solitude to "recharge."

Receive emotional energy from being with other people, and find that solitude drains energy from them. They need time with other people to "recharge."





#### How we structure our lives:

Controlled 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 Spontaneous

Prefer outcomes to processes. Interested in structure, meeting deadlines, closure, moving on to the next thing. Tend to like checklists and plans.

Prefer processes to outcomes. More interested in "going with the flow" and "seeing what happens" than making schedules and meeting deadlines. Tend to lose their checklists and plans, but it doesn't bother them!





#### How we take in information:

Intuitive 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 Sensing

Often describe themselves as "innovative." Like metaphor & imagery, and often understand complex ideas rather suddenly, "as a whole," without knowing exactly how they know. Tend to be more interested in what "might be" rather than what "is."

Often describe themselves as "practical." They gather information bit by bit, and focus on facts, data and experience. Tend to be more interested in what "is" rather than what "might be."





#### How we make decisions:

Thinking 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 Feeling

Focus more on facts, data, rules, and procedures than on how decisions will affect people.

Focus more on how a decision will affect other people than on facts, data, rules, and procedures.

- We have all been shaped by our experiences in life.
- Family what did you learn growing up in your family?
- Educational experiences what were your favourite subjects in school?
- Vocational what jobs have you been most effective in and enjoyed most?
- Spiritual what have been your most meaningful times with God?
- Ministry how have you served God/church in the past?
- Painful what problems, hurts, thorns and trials have you learned from?
