
European Values Study


The Integrated Values Surveys (IVS) is a combination of two wide-ranging surveys: The European Values Study (EVS) and the World Values Survey (WVS). So far, the IVS has had seven "waves." Wave 1 was conducted 1981–1984 and Wave 7 was conducted 2017–2022. Our study uses the data from Wave 7.













Nonreligous by Country

In this chart, four categories of the nonreligious have been separated out:


- ✤ Atheists

Trans-European Division: Philosophical Atheists Regions where more than 10% of the native-born population is philosophical atheist







British Union Conference: Philosophical Atheism Regions where more than 10% of the native-born population identifies as atheist



British Union - London: Philosophical Atheism

The native-born population of this NUTS 2 region is approximately 323,000. Of these, 50% identify as atheists yielding approximately 161,500 native-born atheists. All of these have some amount of tertiary-level education. Eighty percent of them are in the top 20% of wage-earners.
