

Purpose of departments

- To enable the church to serve its members
- To enrich the church with personnel, resources, ideas and creativity



The elder and departments

Under and in cooperation with the pastor, elders are spiritual leaders of the church and are responsible for fostering all departments and activities of the work. Elders should maintain a mutually helpful relationship with other officers.

The elders role is to support the departments as a counsellor and mentor.

Deacons & Deaconesses

- Visitation and care for sick & poor
- Administering ordinances (baptism & communion)
- Care & maintenance of church property



Deacons & Deaconesses


- Cannot fill their office until ordained
- Not authorised to preside at Lord's supper, baptism, business meeting, or to perform marriage ceremony or officiate transfer of members.

Church Clerk

- Keeps church records
- Records minutes of board and business meetings
- Membership transfers
- Corresponds with members



Church Treasurer

- Custodian of all funds
- Conference funds, local church funds
- Prompt issuing of receipts
- Regular reports
- Confidential relations with members
- Auditing


